Creative career planning and implementation of career plans (introduction of the expert, interactive exercises)

Drama applied to career development (based on the methods of Augusto Boal)

At the end of the training session was designed the plan of the chapter "Proactive career management" from the PATH FOR CAREER guide and the methods and strategies that will be used during the training workshops with the members of the target group were established.
